ANNOUNCING THE APALÁI BIBLE

World Missions is pleased and honored to announce the completion of the new Apalaí Bible—both Old Testament and New Testament—for the Apalaí, an indigenous people group living in northern Brazil. Copies of the Apalaí Bible were made available just this month after many years of work by FPCC members, Ed and Sally Koehn, who worked on this project as Wycliffe Bible translators to Brazil from 1964 to 1994 and then during their retirement years in Chattanooga. We praise God for the printing of His Holy Word in Apalaí. And we honor Ed and Sally for their love for and devotion to the Apalaí who now have the scriptures in their mother tongue. Note: The Apalaí Bible will be dedicated at the World Missions Conference this October.

Please be in prayer for our team that just arrived in Peru yesterday, June 30. Members of the team are Rev. Chris Bowen (leader), Abby Alston, Lynette Alston, Chris Henegar, and Stephanie Young.
