“While Jesus ministered to the masses, he focused his time and training on a small number of disciples. He was closer to the Twelve than to the seventy, and closer to the three (Peter, James, and John) than to the rest of the Twelve. Instead of dissipating the bulk of his energy on the curious multitudes, our Lord concentrated on a handful of people who were teachable and committed. By building his life into these men, he was equipping them to reach an ever-widening circle of people through multiplication rather than addition. As Robert A. Coleman put it in *The Master Plan of Evangelism*, ‘Better to give a year or so to one or two people who learn what it means to conquer for Christ than spend a lifetime with a congregation just keeping the program going.’ We would do well to invite God to raise up and send us the people he wants us to nurture instead of recruiting people on our own. Prayerful and patient discernment on the front end will make us far more effective in the long term. True discipleship requires a significant investment of time and energy, and we want our limited resources to bear a much fruit as possible.”
