September 14, 1938 – December 31, 2018

Subsequently, Paul served as the Coordinator for *Mission to the World*, the Executive Director of *The Evangelical Fellowship of Mission Agencies (EFMA)*, and Ambassador at Large for *The Mission Exchange* (now *Missio Nexus*). Paul will be fondly remembered as a missionary statesman and strategic thinker who loved the nations and left his mark on world missions. Our prayers go out to Paul's family and particularly Joanne, who suffers from Alzheimer's and is being cared for by family and friends in Charlottesville, Virginia.
