IN MEMORIAM - KATIE VAN ZYL

JUNE 19, 1954 - MARCH 15, 2019

World Missions is heartbroken to announce the sudden passing of our mission partner, Katie Van Zyl, who had served in Bogotá, Colombia with her husband Bob since 1977. Katie and Bob translated the New Testament (published in 1991) and Old Testament portions into the Camsá Indian language and then worked as consultants—Bob in the area of Bible translation and Katie in literacy-Scripture use with members of over 40 people groups in the region. Most recently Katie served as the literacy team coordinator for the SIL Americas Area Scripture Engagement (SE) Core Team—working alongside various indigenous and Latin Christian leaders to develop new SE strategies and facilitate discipleship and training activities. Bob currently serves as the Americas Regional Director for SIL's Global Sign Language Team. He had been working in Honduras at the time of Katie's passing.

Katie was a delightful lady who always had a smile on her face. She served her Lord well—having left a loving legacy of God's Word to the people of Latin America. Katie leaves behind her loving family, Bob, daughters Amy (husband Jorge) and Katie Ann, and granddaughters, Isabella, Sofia, and Laura; plus her many friends around the world and colleagues with United World Missions and SIL International.

The World Missions Team gives God Almighty all praise and honor for Katie Van Zyl, our dear friend and gospel partner of 41 years. We will miss her very much but are grateful that she is present with her loving Lord and Savior. Thank you very much for keeping Katie's family in your prayers.
