CITY TO CITY LATIN AMERICA IN BRAZIL

This past week, City to City Latin America hosted *A Great Gospel for a Great City* for over 5,000 Brazilian church leaders in Sao Paulo and Rio de Janeiro with featured speakers, Dr. Tim Keller, Dr. Paul Tripp, and Dr. Augustus Nicodemus, Presbyterian minister and former chancellor of Mackenzie Presbyterian University in Sao Paulo. FPCC partners, Andreas Garza and Jay Kyle planned this conference that emphasized the need to create new types of churches in urban centers to deal with the rapid transformation of society. Tim, Andreas, and Jay met with church leaders to review what has been learned in the Brazilian context about planting and revitalizing churches and developing leadership to successfully bring the gospel of Jesus Christ to the cities of Brazil. The event also reflected upon how churches in all regions can have fellowship and collaboration in unity—motivating and empowering pastors, planters, and city leaders to share the gospel effectively. Ruth Garza had opportunities to minister to the wives of church planters, and she made a presentation on the value of ministering to women through Parakaleo. Please pray that the Lord will produce much fruit throughout Brazil from this conference.
