INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS OF THE WEEK

Andrew and Kelly Baxley serve with the United Church of Bogotá, the only English-speaking evangelical church in the city of 10+ million. The congregation—made up of dozens of nationalities—serves the city's enormous international community through evangelism and discipleship ministries. The church also serves as a support system to the local network of indigenous church plants within Bogotá and throughout Colombia. Andrew's primary role as a pastor is to focus on the community's youth and families. Kelly founded a counseling ministry in the church to provide a desperately needed service for members as well as for local missionaries. The couple also serves alongside Next, MTW's ministry to missionary kids and their families that promotes spiritual health and, thus, longevity of service on the mission field. Andrew and Kelly have two sons, Silas (1½ years) and Thomas (3½ months). Please be in prayer for the Baxleys as they will be involved with two upcoming Next events. June 30-July 6, they will host a missionary kid retreat in Bogotá for MK's in the Americas region of MTW. At Ridge Haven from July 12-20, they will be holding individual counseling debriefing sessions with MK's aged 9 to 19 to help them process their lives on the field or with their transition from the field.
