## INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS OF THE WEEK

*Jeff and Misha Marlowe*

Since August 2001, Jeff has served as the area director for training and development for Mission to the World (MTW) Enterprise. He also directs the learning and development function for all of MTW. Jeff travels regularly to facilitate and consult with MTW's field teams, regions, and national partners. Mischa teaches language acquisition skills to new missionaries. Prior to this, the couple led a church planting team in a capital city of West Africa. The Marlowes are currently in Europe for the month of July—along with six interns and five staff—to lead orientation and training for 17 new MTW missionaries and 17 children. Among the group is Louisa D for whom our church has provided funding for a two-year assignment in southern Asia. Your prayers for Jeff and Mischa, their team, and the new missionaries and their children are greatly appreciated. Serving in missions abroad can be very stressful and challenging. This training—the final step for these missionaries before they deploy—will attempt to duplicate scenarios that will occur on the field. Thus, in actuality final screening is taking place. Please pray for all concerned. Jeff particularly asks for prayer that the training equips the missionaries well and that all maintain positive attitudes.
